



January Meeting Minutes

Burnet County Republican Women Minutes of General Meeting – December 8, 2022 Sylvester H. Reed Memorial Building – Burnet, Texas

Welcome, Call to Order, and Opening Ceremonies: President Mary Jane Avery welcomed everyone and called the meeting to order at 11:30 a.m., and a lunch was served. Chaplain Sue Boss Lee gave the invocation, and Damon Beirele led the pledges to the American and Texas flags. Sue reported that our club provided 130 wreaths. On December 17th, 2000 wreaths will be laid on the graves in Pflugerville. She encouraged everyone to join her there.

Introductions: Local elected officials, precinct chairs, and guests introduced themselves. Mary Jane introduced special guests Kit Whitehill, TFRW President, and Zenia Warren, TFRW 1st Vice President. She presented our caterer Kevin Bailey with a gift of appreciation.

Approval of Minutes: The November minutes were published in the newsletter. There were no corrections. They stand approved as distributed.

Caring for America: Deborah Smith reported that the funds collected today would go to the Burnet County Child Welfare Board to provide Christmas gifts for the children. She explained the mission of this organization.

Membership: We currently have 64 members. Janice Estill reminded us to pay our dues so that we can continue being a Jumbo Club.

Presentations: Gail Teegarden and Kit Whitehill presented the TFRW Woman of Distinction Award to Janet Parker for her outstanding career and accomplishments as the Burnet County Clerk. Mary Jane presented a pin to Linda Berggren for her accomplishments as the 5th top caller in the state for making 22,275 calls.

Review of Past Year's Accomplishments: Mary Jane reminded us of our club's accomplishments in 2022: fabulous speakers, chili cook off, Reagan dinner, GOP picnic, Bluebonnet Festival Booth, TFRW events, Jumbo membership, Caring for America contributions, Membership Drive phone calls, block walking, various signs, boards, and newspaper articles, and a contribution in our club's name to the Highland Lakes Service League golf tournament by Carolyn Richmond and Judy Salvaggio.

Notes from Burnet County Republican Party Chair: Kara Chasteen gave a report about voter turnout in Burnet County. In 2022, 53% of registered Republicans voted compared to 83% of Democrats. This is worrisome as it will not be too long before Democrats have local candidates in our races. She will speak at Chamber, Rotary, and other organization meetings to try to get more 30- and 40-year-olds to vote. She challenged us to talk to 10 people and invite them to meetings and to look at our website. Candidate signs need to be thrown away. "Vote Republican" signs can be given to Kara, Gail, or Mary Jane.

Treasurer's Report: We currently have a total of \$27,250.35 in our Operating account and \$6,985.09 in Scholarships. There is \$34,243.24 total in our account.

Campaign Activities: Mary Jane recognized those who worked the elections in various forms. She gave a report from Georgia and thanked those who helped with funds for the strike force.

New Business

- The Bylaws and Standing Rules were emailed, and copies were on the table. The motion to accept the Bylaws was made by Dorine Petru and seconded by Kara Chasteen. The motion passed. The motion to accept the Standing Rules was made by Gail Teegarden and seconded by Wanda Kauffman. The motion passed. Mary Jane thanked Janet Crow, Gail Teegarden, and Darlene Hargett for working on the Bylaws Committee.
- · Kit Whitehill installed the 2023-2024 officers: President, Mary Jane Avery; f^t Vice President, Gail Teegarden; 2nd Vice President, Carolyn Alexander; Secretary, Darlene Hargett; Treasurer, Dottie Stueckroth; PAC Treasurer, Carolyn Richmond; and Assistant Treasurer, Brenda Miles.

Program: Kit Whitehill reflected on TFRW through the ages. It was founded in 1955, and NFRW was founded in 1938. Recent accomplishments include five strike force events, the post card initiative, and training over 50 first-time candidates in South Texas. Goals include registering more voters, getting members more involved, and creating a new brochure. Nuts and Bolts training for club officers will be held in Georgetown on January 27th. The TFRW Convention will be held October 12-14 in Irving. The theme is Building Strong Leaders for Texas.


