friendship!

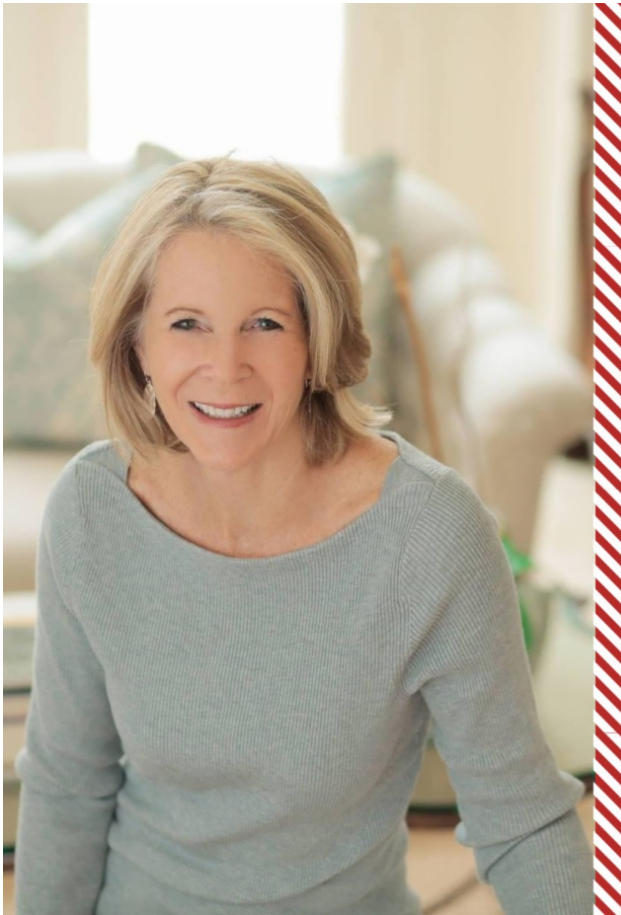

Minutes of General Meeting – November 14, 2024

Sylvester H. Reed Memorial Building – Burnet, Texas

Welcome, Call to Order, and Opening Ceremonies: President Mary Jane Avery welcomed everyone and called the meeting to order at 11:35 A.M., and a lunch was served. Ginger Chuter gave the invocation followed by the pledges to the American and Texas flags led by Mike Salvaggio.
