



IN GOD WE TRUST PROJECT

A new law requiring Texas schools to display donated "In God We Trust"

posters is the latest move by Republican lawmakers to bring Christianity into taxpayer-funded institutions.

Under the law, <u>Senate Bill 797</u>, which passed during last year's legislative session, schools are required to display the posters if they are donated.

The law went into effect last year, but these posters weren't popping up then as many school officials and parents were more concerned about new COVID-19 strains and whether their local public school would even open for in-person classes.

The "In God We Trust" law was authored by state Sen. <u>Bryan Hughes</u>, the East Texas Republican who crafted Texas' Senate Bill 8, which restricted abortion to the first six weeks or so of pregnancy starting Sept. 1, 2021. The abortion law artfully skirted legal challenge by relying on the public instead of law enforcement to enforce it.

Hughes' "In God We Trust" poster law is also precisely written. Texas public schools or colleges must display the national motto in a "conspicuous place" but only if the poster is "donated" or "purchased by private donations." After an appearance for a Northwest Austin Republican Women's Club event on Tuesday, <u>Hughes touted</u> the new law and praised the groups stepping up to donate the posters.

"The national motto, In God We Trust, asserts our collective trust in a sovereign God," Hughes wrote on Twitter. "I'm encouraged to see groups like the Northwest [Austin] Republican Women and many individuals coming forward to donate these framed prints to remind future generations of the national motto."





May Meeting Minutes

Burnet County Republican Women PAC Minutes of General Meeting – May 12, 2022 Sylvester H. Reed Memorial Building – Burnet, Texas

Welcome, Call to Order, and Opening Ceremonies: President Mary Jane Avery welcomed everyone and called the meeting to order at 11:35 a.m., and a lunch was served. Leslie Fitzpatrick, candidate for Justice 3rd Court of Appeals, Place 4 gave the invocation, and Janet Crow led the pledges to the American and Texas flags.

Introductions: President Mary Jane introduced local elected officials, precinct chairs, candidates, and guests. Two candidates were present, Leslie Fitzpatrick and

Ellen Troxclair. They each said a few words about their campaign.

Approval of Minutes: The February minutes were placed on each table. There were no corrections. They stand approved as distributed.

Membership Report: Membership Chair, Janet Estill, reported that we have 133 members.

Caring for America: Mary Jane thanked those who contributed over \$400 in food and gift cards for the Helping Center.

Signage at Service League Golf Tournament: Carolyn Richmond and Judy Salvaggio each donated \$500 representing BCRW for signage at the Highland Lakes Service League Ladies Charity Golf Tournament.

Mary Jane thanked those who came early to the April meeting and wrote postcards for getting Republicans registered to vote.

Program: Wanda Kauffman, Scholarship Chair, gave a brief summary of the scholarship process. Each recipient was introduced and read his/her essay. Students who received a \$1000 scholarship are Daniel Holland from Faith Academy, Zoe Nicholl from Burnet High School, and Hudson McBryde from Marble Falls High School.

Following the essay readings, Judge James Oakley spoke about his role as County Judge. He is an administrative judge who oversees the Commissioners' Court and handles the business of the county. The County Court at Law handles the court side. He spoke about the growth of the county - 10% population growth per year - and the affects that growth has on the county. Questions and answers followed his presentation.

New Business: Mary Jane proposed that BCRW sponsor one student to attend the Texas Youth Leadership Summit at a cost of \$150. Londa Chandler seconded the motion, and the motion passed.

Announcements:

- \cdot Poll workers who get paid for their service can now count those hours as campaign hours for TFRW.
- · Members have participated in five blockwalkings. The next blockwalking with occur Saturday, May 14th in Delaware Springs. Linda Stewart, precinct 2 chair, has organized it. Three drivers and six walkers are needed. Those interested should meet in the Old Beall's parking lot in Burnet at 10:00 a.m.
- The June 9th summer social will be at 7:00 at 101 Falling Creek Cove in Marble Falls. It will be a Charcuterie board contest with music by Triple Bogey. BYOB.
- · Londa Chandler urged everyone to get out to vote. Only 9% of voters voted in the previous election. Early voting is May 16-20, and election day is May 24.
- · The next meeting of the Burnet County Republican Club will be at Putters and Gutters. Date and time to be announced.
- · Thank you to the Hospitality Committee and Kevin for lunch.

The meeting was adjourned at 12:55 with the singing of "God Bless America."
