How does it work?

1. Scan the QR Code to have your information sent to Amariah Pinchback (apinchback,2020@gmail.com).
2. You will receive your username and password.
3. Using a GOOGLE or FIREFOX Browser ... go to **reddialer.gop**
4. Login - Select how many calls you would like to make
5. Click - using a PC or LANDLINE
6. Select Call list
7. Connect & Start Call - be ready! - it pops up quickly
8. Read Script
9. Mark Survey Response Options
10. Leave a message if possible
11. Start the next call

* You will be assigned to an awesome Regional Director to help you with glitches, encouragement and project updates.

* We have multiple weekly ZOOM trainings to guide you

The NFRW Campaign Committee announced changes to what will be reported and how hours are reported.

All members can now count -

- Hours spent at club general meeting
- Hours that were paid - only if it is not your primary source of income, (stipend salaries, Election worker, block walking, phone banking)
- Hours at paid for events – ie; Lincoln and Reagan Day

Members need to track

- # of volunteer hours in a period even paid hours.
- # Political calls they have made in a period (note- the hours doing the calls are counted under volunteer hours)

Campaign Activities Chairs will

Track members hours and calls by member

Report to TFRW quarterly

- Total # of hours for their club
- Total # of calls for their club
- Name & # hours of members with highest amount of hours
- Name & # calls of member with highest number of calls

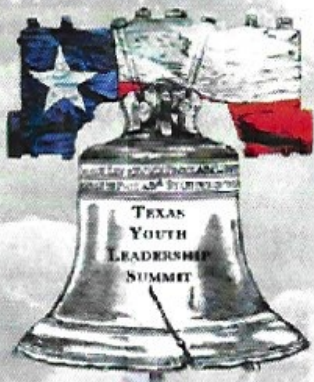
