
Also, please come to the front door as there is construction at the end of our driveway. Safety first. Invite and bring friends.

- 3. Using a GOOGLE or FIREFOX Browser ... go to reddialer.gop
- 4. Login Select how many calls you would lke to make
- 5. Click using a PC or LANDLINE
- 6. Select Call list
- 7. Connect & Start Call be ready! it pops up quickly
- 8. Read Script
- 9. Mark Survey Response Options
- 10. Leave a message if possible
- 11. Start the next call
- * You will be assigned to an awesome Regional Director to help you with glitches, encouragement and project updates.
- * We have multiple weekly ZOOM trainings to guide you

The NFRW Campaign Committee announced changes to what will be reported and how hours are reported.

All members can now count -

- Hours spent at club general meeting
- Hours that were paid only if it is not your primary source of income, (stipend salaries, Election worker, block walking, phone banking)
- o Hours at paid for events ie; Lincoln and Reagan Day

Members need to track

- # of volunteer hours in a period even paid hours.
