
May 24 is the Runoff Election. Talk to your friends and neighbors and get them out to **VOTE!**

Burnet County Republican Women PAC Minutes of General Meeting – March 10, 2022 Sylvester H. Reed Memorial Building – Burnet, Texas



PROPERTY TAXES

PROPOSITION 1.

WOULD DRAW DOWN PROPERTY TAXES FOR ELDERLY AND DISABLED TEXANS BY REDUCING THE AMOUNT THEY PAY TO PUBLIC SCHOOLS, WHICH TYPICALLY MAKES UP MOST OF A HOMEOWNER'S TAX BILL. THE STATE WOULD THEN COVER THAT REDUCED REVENUE FOR SCHOOL DISTRICTS.

PROPOSITION 2.




