February Meeting Minutes

Burnet County Republican Women PAC Minutes of General Meeting – February 10, 2022 Sylvester H. Reed Memorial Building – Burnet, Texas

Welcome, Call to Order, and Opening Ceremonies: President Mary Jane Avery welcomed everyone and called the meeting to order at 11:40 a.m., and a lunch was served. Chaplain Sue Boss Lee gave the invocation, and Judy Salvaggio led the pledges to the American and Texas flags.

Introductions: First Lady of Texas Cecilia Abbott was introduced as a special guest. Local elected officials, precinct chairs, candidates, and guests introduced themselves.

Approval of Minutes: The January minutes were published in the newsletter. There were no corrections. They stand approved as published.

Treasurer's Report: Dottie Stueckroth reported the following: Total income as of January 31 is \$2,046 and expenses were \$3,738.70. We have \$2,248.09 in the scholarship fund and an operating balance of \$18,470.73 giving a total of \$20,728.82.

Membership Report: Membership Chair Janice Estill reported that we have 3 new members today.

Chili Cookoff: Chair Wanda Kauffman reminded everyone about the chili cookoff February 12th at the Freedom Flyers hangar in Burnet and that \$6000 is needed to fund three scholarships for 2 years. These funds come from the silent and live auctions. She listed some of the live auction items and urged everyone to attend.

Reagan Dinner: Trixie Bond gave a report on the plans for the Reagan dinner. It will be held at Log Country Cove on March 10. Governor Greg Abbott will be the keynote speaker, and Dan Dunn, American speed painting sensation of Paint Jam, will paint four paintings to be auctioned that night. Tickets can be purchased on Eventbrite, on a QR code, or from Trixie.

Program: Mary Jane introduced our moderator, Janet Parker, who briefed the candidates on rules. County Court At Law candidates, Angela Dowdle and Cody Henson, were given 5 minutes to present background information and why they are running for this position. House District 19 candidates Ellen Troxclair, Perla Hopkins, and Justin Berry stated their background and answered questions submitted by the audience.

Announcements:

• Mary Jane reminded everyone that right now we as individuals work for our favorite candidates, but on election night, we come together as a club to support the elected Republican candidates. The purpose of the chili cookoff is to collect funds to help candidates who have a Democratic opponent.

• Kara Chasteen reported that the precinct and county conventions will be March 26 at the Reed Building. You must apply to be a delegate. Burnet County needs 28 delegates and 28 alternates.

• There will be a potluck election night watch party at the Reed Building.

• Election workers are needed as backups. Floaters are also needed for election day and workers for early voting. Contact Susan Doyle if you are interested. If candidates want signs out at any of the 21 precincts in the county, contact Susan.

Workers are needed for the GOP Bluebonnet Festival Booth.


Thank you to Carolyn Alexander, her Hospitality Committee, and Kevin for a delicious lunch.


