About our speaker . . .

ANTHONY T. TRIOLA
CHIEF WARRANT OFFICER FOUR (RET)
UNITED STATES ARMY

Chief Warrant Officer Four (CW4) Anthony Triola retired on

January 31, 2014, after serving 24 years, 7 months on active duty.

His military career began in 1989, when Anthony enlisted in the United States Air Force and served as an Intelligence Operations Specialist. Following the attacks of September 11th, 2001, Anthony applied to the United States Army Warrant Officer Candidate School and received his appointment to Warrant Officer 1 in March 2002. He served in the Brigade, Division and Corps levels of command as an All-Source Intelligence Officer. During his military career, Anthony served a total of 33 months in combat; six months during OPERATION DESERT STORM and 27 months in support of OPERATION IRAQI FREEDOM. His medals include the Legion of Merit, two Bronze Stars, the Defense Meritorious Service Medal and the Meritorious Service Medal.

The highlight of his career was when Anthony served as the Russia Ground Officer for the European Command as well as an adjunct professor of Russian History and Russian Military History at the Regional Joint Intelligence Training Facility, RAF Molesworth, England, from 2009 to 2012.

For the past four years Anthony has been teaching Russian History at Senior University, which offers a diverse program of classes, lectures, travel activities, and learning opportunities for persons over 50 years of age in and around Georgetown, Texas. Anthony also work for the American Red Cross as a Disaster Services and Service to the Armed Forces volunteer.

Anthony has been married to his wife Sarah since November 2013, and they have one daughter, Madeleine. The Triola family has lived in the City of Georgetown, Texas, since 2017.

Burnet County Poll Watchers

If you are interested in being a Poll Watcher during the upcoming General Election either early or day of voting, see below:

- You must be a registered voter in Burnet County.
- You must complete Poll Watcher training on the SOS Website. See link here <https://pollworkertraining.sos.texas.gov/>
- When you click on the link to sign up for training it will take you to page where you create your own username and password.
- You must print the Certificate of Completion of Poll Watcher Training and take it with you to the Poll you are assigned to watch. After you complete the training, you will be give the opportunity to print the certificate.
- You must have a certificate of Appointment from me. After you complete your training, I will appoint you where needed and give you that original appointment certificate.

If you can complete the training before the BCRW Luncheon on Oct 13, I will hand that certificate to you there. You must take it and your training certificate and present them to the Election Judge at the Polling Place.

- If you don't attend the meeting, call me and we will find a time to meet. My cell phone is **512-963-2856**.
- You will not be allowed to watch without both certificates.
- Should you have any questions or concerns call me. If you have trouble at the Poll, call me. Always call me.

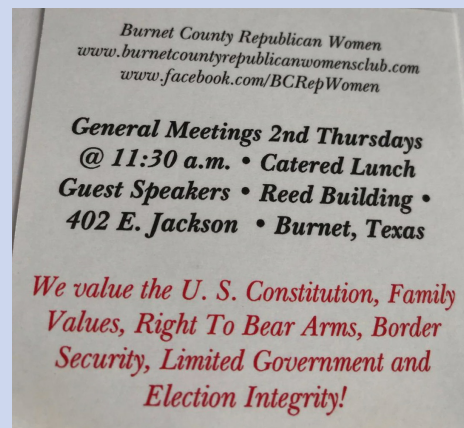

September Meeting Minutes

Burnet County Republican Women PAC Minutes of General Meeting – May 12, 2022 Sylvester H. Reed Memorial Building – Burnet, Texas

Welcome, Call to Order, and Opening Ceremonies: President Mary Jane Avery welcomed everyone and called the meeting to order at 11:35 a.m., and a lunch was served. BCRW Chaplain Sue Boss Lee gave the invocation, and Gail Teegarden led the pledges to the American and Texas flags.

Introductions: President Mary Jane introduced local elected officials, precinct chairs, candidates, and guests. Mary Jane encouraged guests to join and help us elect

Republican candidates.

Approval of Minutes: The May minutes were published in the newsletter. There were no corrections. They stand approved as distributed.

Caring for America: Deborah Smith announced that we were collecting items for the Helping Center.

Americanism: The state legislators have proclaimed that “In God We Trust” should be placed in all schools in Texas. Carleen Kaurin will be calling schools to find out how many are needed.

Scholarship: Wanda Kauffman read thank you notes from our 2022 recipients. She announced the new Scholarship Committee: Brenda Eubank (chair), Pat Bentley, and Judy Salvaggio. The Scholarship Committee is entertaining the idea of changing the question on the scholarship application. At the October meeting, members will have an opportunity to submit a new question.

TFRW Tribute to Women Honorees: Mary Jane announced that the BCRW honorees are Kara Chasteen and Janet Parker. They will be honored at a luncheon on Saturday.

VEP Outstanding Caller: Mary Jane recognized Linda Berggren as the 3rd top caller in the state. She has made almost 20,000 calls. 130,000 new Republican voters have been registered to date.

Program: Gail Teegarden introduced our speaker, Melissa Conway, Texas Election State Director for RPT/RNC. Her topic was Election Integrity. She spoke about transparency in the election process, the need for poll watchers, and voter registration. She stated that our county is in great shape but Williamson, Hays, and Travis are not. That is a concern since they are so close to us. Her job is to equip counties with legal resources of best practices. Our job is to be the eyes, ears, and boots on the ground in every phase of the election process.

- Burnet County is a firewall helping Williamson County candidates. BCRW will be blockwalking in that county on Saturday, September 10, October 1, 8, & 15. Those interested will meet at Burnet Walgreens at 8:00 a.m. and be back by 12:30. Drivers and walkers are needed.
- A beach getaway to Port Aransas is planned for November 13th. A \$100 deposit is needed today to reserve a spot.
- Volunteers are needed for Market Day on Main, Saturday, September 17th. Contact Londa Chandler.
- Election workers are needed. Contact Susan Doyle.
- Tickets are still on sale for the GOP Picnic, Sunday, September 1st.
- Record campaign hours on the sheet provided on each table.
- Yard Signs are available today. Donations are appreciated.
- Gail presented a pin to our club for winning the TFRW top award, the Diamond Award.
- Mary Jane recognized Denise Rives for earning the TFRW Woman of Distinction Award.
- Kara Chasteen showed signs “Keep Texas Great, Vote Republican” to be put around the county. Janice Estill will be in charge of distributing them, and they will be available at the picnic. She also urged members to sign up to be poll workers. The training is online but may be in person if there is enough interest. The next CEP meeting is Monday, September 19th at Putters & Gutters. Tom Maynard, State Board of Education representative, will be the speaker. Please RSVP.

Thank you to BCRW Vice President Carolyn Alexander and her Hospitality Committee.

The meeting was adjourned at 1:00 with the singing of “God Bless America.”

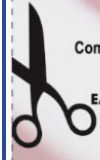
