

Burnet County Republican Women Minutes of General Meeting – November 10, 2022 Sylvester H. Reed Memorial Building – Burnet, Texas

Welcome, Call to Order, and Opening Ceremonies: President Mary Jane Avery welcomed everyone and called the meeting to order at 11:30 a.m., and a lunch was served. County Commissioner Damon Beierle gave the invocation, and Kay Stripling led the pledges to the American and Texas flags.

Introductions: Local elected officials, precinct chairs, and guests introduced themselves. Mary Jane introduced special guest Kellye Duncan, TFRW Deputy

President, and Chip Howell, who was selling items to support projects around Texas from his "Elephant in the Room Strategies" display.

Approval of Minutes: The October minutes were published in the newsletter. There were no corrections. They stand approved as distributed.

Program: Gail Teegarden asked all veterans to stand and be recognized. She then introduced Mark Bentley to moderate the program. He introduced four veterans, Jeff Lofgreen, Charlie Mercer, Rob Paul, and Lamar Chuter. These men had recently gone on the Honor Flight to Washington D.C. Each man told us where he had served and in what war. They then talked about their experiences on the Honor Flight. Londa Chandler and Gail Teegarden presented each veteran with a quilt made by Londa. Londa had also made a quilt to honor Bruce Richmond, husband of Carolyn, who recently passed away. Carolyn was present to receive the quilt.

Caring For America: Thanks to all who brought cake mixes, gift cards, and monetary donations for the Helping Center.

Membership: Membership dues are now due. We ended the year with 138 members and were a Jumbo Club. We want to keep our status.

Bylaws Review: Members of the Bylaws Committee are Janet Crow, Gail Teegarden, and Darlene Hargett. They recently reviewed and revised our bylaws to comply with TFRW bylaws. They were emailed to our members on November 7th and will be voted on at the December 8th meeting. Janet highlighted some changes. Dues, fees, expenses, and other payments are explained in the Standing Rules. Assistant Treasurer will be eliminated, and Brenda Miles' term will be up at the end of December. Two new positions are two Members at Large. Carolyn Alexander nominated Judy Salvaggio with a second by Janet Crow. The motion passed. Gail Teegarden nominated Joy Evans, second by Joyce Smith. The motion passed. These ladies will serve as Members at Large for 2023-24.
