The Fourth of July commemorates the adoption of the Declaration of Independence. It was initially adopted by

Congress on July 2, 1776, but was revised and the final version was adopted two days later.

America's second president John Adams believed that July 2nd should have been celebrated as Independence Day instead of July 4th.

John Adams, the second president, and Thomas Jefferson, the third president both signatorys of the Declaration of Independence 50 years prior, died hours apart on July 4, 1826.



DID YOU?

Denmark began throwing a Fourth of July bash in 1912 after thousands of Danes emigrated to the United States, to this day it is still celebrated in Denmark.

In 1998, Congress passed a bill declaring the 21 days between Flag Day and Independence Day as "Honor America Days."

70 Benjamin Franklin (age 70) was the oldest of the signers.

26 Edward Rutledge (age 26) was the youngest.

John Hancock, President of the Second Continental Congress, was the first signer.
