October Meeting Minutes

Burnet County Republican Women PAC Minutes of General Meeting – October 13, 2022 Sylvester H. Reed Memorial Building – Burnet, Texas

Welcome, Call to Order, and Opening Ceremonies: President Mary Jane Avery welcomed everyone and called the meeting to order at 11:35 a.m., and a lunch was served. BCRW Chaplain Sue Boss Lee gave the invocation, and Vicinta Stafford led the pledges to the American and Texas flags.

Introductions: Local elected officials, precinct chairs, candidates, and guests introduced themselves. Mary Jane introduced State Representative candidate Caroline

Harris and Leslie Fitzpatrick, candidate for Judge, 3rd Court of Appeals who spoke a few words about their campaigns and beliefs.

Approval of Minutes: The September minutes were published in the newsletter. There were no corrections. They stand approved as distributed.

Caring for America: Sue Boss Lee discussed the Wreaths Across America project. Wreaths can be purchased for \$15 each to remember the lives of veterans at the Pflugerville Cemetery. The ceremony will be at 11:00 a.m. on December 17th and will be celebrated at veteran cemeteries all across America, in Normandy, and Germany. The Helping Center is asking for help in November. Mary Jane will send out a list of their needs.

Membership: We received the Jumbo Club award from TFRW for the number of members that we have. Janice Estill announced that 2022-2023 dues are now due. We received two new members today and would like to grow our club to 150 members.

Election: Susan Doyle announced that seven more workers are needed. Kara discussed poll watchers. We do not need them in Burnet County, but they are needed elsewhere.

Program: Gail Teegarden introduced our speaker, Anthony Triola, Russian Intelligence Operations Specialist, retired military officer, and Burnet County disaster relief agent. He gave us the history of Russia and Ukraine and an update on the war in Ukraine. He discussed the Kerch Bridge attack. He said Russian troops are fleeing, and the Russian population is getting older. The U.S. and Russia are in a proxy war. Russia will eventually make us pay for our involvement with Ukraine. It may be in the form of cyber attacks, threats to population centers, or threats to public transportation and air travel. Mary Jane presented a book titled Trump and Churchill to be placed in a local library in Mr. Triola's honor.

New Business:

- Nominating Committee: Three members were nominated to serve on the Nominating Committee: Janet Parker, Kay Stripling, and Kara Chasteen. Londa Chandler made a motion to accept these nominations, and Roxanne Nelson seconded the motion. The motion passed. This committee will present a slate of officers for 2023-24 at the November meeting, and we will vote on the slate at that time.
- **Bylaws Review:** Gail Teegarden, Janet Crow, and Darlene Hargett are in the process of reviewing and revising our bylaws to comply with TFRW bylaws. They will be presented and voted on at the November meeting.


